



CROCHET | SKILL LEVEL: **EASY**

## ABBREVIATIONS

**Beg** = Begin(ning)

**Ch** = Chain(s)

**Dcbp** = Yoh and draw up a loop around post of next stitch at front of work,

inserting hook from right to left. (Yoh and draw through 2 loops on hook) twice

st at back of work

inserting hook from

right to left. (Yoh and

draw through 2 loops

on hook) twice

**Hdc** = Half double

crochet

**Hdc2tog** = (Yoh and

draw up a loop in

next stitch) twice. Yoh

and draw through all

loops on hook

**Pat** = Pattern

**PM** = Place marker

**Rem** = Remain(ing)

**Rep** = Repeat

**RS** = Right side

## MATERIALS

**Bernat® Blanket™** (10.5 oz/300 g; 220 yds/201 m)

Sizes	6/8	10/12	yrs
<b>Main Color (MC)</b> Teal Dreams (10736)	4	5	<b>balls</b>
<b>Contrast A</b> Vintage White (10006)	1	1	<b>ball</b>

Sizes U.S. K/10½ (6.5 mm) and U.S. N/13 (10 mm) crochet hooks **or size needed to obtain gauge.** Stitch markers. Yarn needle.

## SIZES

**To fit chest measurement**

**6/8 yrs** 25-26½" [63.5-67.5 cm]

**10/12 yrs** 28-30" [71-76 cm]

**Finished chest measurement**

**6/8 yrs** 48" [119.5 cm]

**10/12 yrs** 58" [147.5 cm]

## GAUGE

6 sc and 7 rows = 4" [10 cm] with larger hook.

## INSTRUCTIONS

*The instructions are written for smaller size. If changes are necessary for larger size the instruction will be written thus ( ). Numbers for each size are shown in the same color throughout the pattern. When only one number is given in black, it applies to both sizes.*

## Notes:

- Body is worked Side-to-side in one piece.
- Sleeves are worked down from edges of Body.
- Hood is worked separately and sewn onto Body.
- Ch 3 at beg of row counts as dc.
- Ch 2 at beg of row **does not** count as st.

## BODY

Beg at left side, with larger hook and MC, ch **78 (90)**.

**1st row:** (RS). 1 sc in 2nd ch from hook. \*1 dc in next ch. 1 sc in next ch. Rep from \* to end of chain. Turn. **77 (89)** sts.

**2nd row:** Ch 3. \*1 sc in next dc. 1 dc in next sc. Rep from \* to end of row. Turn.

**3rd row:** Ch 1. 1 sc in first dc. \*1 dc in next sc. 1 sc in next dc. Rep from \* to end of row. Turn. Rep last 2 rows for pat until work from beg measures **10 (10½)" [25.5 (26.5) cm]**, ending on a WS row.

## Shape Back neck opening:

**1st row:** (RS- dividing row). Ch 1. 1 sc in first dc. (1 dc in next sc. 1 sc in next dc) **18 (21)** times. **Turn.** Leave rem sts unworked.

**2nd row:** Ch 3. \*1 sc in next dc. 1 dc in next sc. Rep from \* to end of row. Turn.

**3rd row:** Ch 1. 1 sc in first dc. \*1 dc in next sc. 1 sc in next dc. Rep from \* to end of row. Turn. Rep last 2 rows for pat until work from dividing row measures **7 (8)" [18 (20.5) cm]**, ending on a RS row. Fasten off.

## Shape Left Front neck opening:

**1st row:** (RS). Skip first 3 sts. Join MC with sl st to next st. Ch 2. Hdc2tog over same st as last sl st and next st. Pat to end of row. Turn. **36 (42)** sts.

**2nd row:** Pat to last 2 sts. Hdc2tog. Turn. **35 (41)** sts.

**3rd row:** Ch 2. Hdc2tog. Pat to end of row. Turn. **34 (40)** sts. Cont even in pat over **34 (40)** sts until neck from dividing row measures 2 rows shorter than Back neck opening, ending on a RS row.

## Shape Right Front neck opening:

**1st row:** (WS). Pat to last st. Work 2 sts in last st. Turn. **35 (41)** sts.

**2nd row:** Work 2 sts in first st. Pat to end of row. Turn. **36 (42)** sts.

**Joining row:** (WS). Pat to last st. Work 2 sts in last st. Ch 3. Pat across **37 (43)** sts of Back. Turn.

**Next row:** (RS). Ch 1. 1 sc in first dc. (1 dc in next sc. 1 sc in next dc) **18 (21)** times. 1 dc in next ch. 1 sc in next ch. 1 dc in next ch. (1 sc in next dc. 1 dc in next sc) **18 (21)** times. 1 sc in last dc. Turn. **77 (89)** sts.

Cont even in pat until work from joining row measures **10 (10½)" [25.5 (26.5) cm]**, ending on a RS row. Fasten off.

## SLEEVES

**Left Sleeve:** With RS facing, skip first **28 (32)** sts of last row of Body. With larger hook, join MC with sl st to next sc and proceed as follows:

**1st row:** (RS). Ch 1. 1 sc in first dc. (1 dc in next sc. 1 sc in next dc) **10 (12)** times. **Turn.** Leave rem sts unworked. **21 (25)** sts.

**\*\*2nd row:** Ch 3. \*1 sc in next dc. 1 dc in next sc. Rep from \* to end of row. Turn.

**3rd row:** Ch 1. 1 sc in first dc. \*1 dc in next sc. 1 sc in next dc. Rep from \* to end of row. Turn.

**4th row:** As 2nd row.

**5th row:** Ch 2. Hdc2tog. Pat to last 2 sts. Hdc2tog. Turn. **19 (23)** sts.

**6th to 8th rows:** Work even in pat.

**9th row:** Ch 2. Hdc2tog. Pat to last 2 sts. Hdc2tog. Turn. **17 (21)** sts.

Cont even in pat until Sleeve from pick up row measures 9" [23 cm], ending on a WS row.

**Next row:** (RS). Ch 2. 1 hdc in each of first **1 (2)** st(s). \*Hdc2tog. 1 hdc in next st. Rep from \* to last st. 1 hdc in last st. **12 (15)** sts. Break MC. Join A.

**Next row:** With A, ch 2. 1 hdc in each st to end of row. Turn.

**Next row:** Ch 2. 1 dcbp around each hdc to end of row. Fasten off.\*\*

**Right Sleeve:** With RS facing, skip first **28 (32)** ch from foundation ch of Body. Join MC with sl st to next st and proceed as follows:

**1st row:** (RS). Ch 1. 1 sc in same sp as sl st. *Working in rem loops of foundation ch*, (1 dc in next sc. 1 sc in next dc) **10 (12)** times. **Turn.** Leave rem sts unworked. **21 (25)** sts.

Work from \*\* to \*\* as given for Left Sleeve.

## FINISHING

Sew side and sleeve seams.

**Bottom edging: 1st rnd:** (RS). With larger hook, join A with sl st to side seam. Ch 2. Work 60 hdc evenly around. Join with sl st to first hdc.

**Turn.**

**2nd rnd: (WS).** Ch 2. Work 1 dcfp around each hdc around. Join with sl st to first st. Fasten off.

## HOOD

With larger hook and A, ch **35 (39)** loosely.

**1st row:** 1 hdc in 3rd ch from hook. 1 hdc in each ch to end of chain. Turn. **33 (37)** sts.

**2nd row:** Ch 2. 1 dcfp around each hdc to end of row. Join MC. Break A. Turn.

With MC, proceed in pat as follows:  
**1st row:** (RS). Ch 1. 1 sc in first st. \*1 dc in next st. 1 sc in next st. Rep from \* to end of row. Turn.

**2nd row:** Ch 3. \*1 sc in next dc. 1 dc in next sc. Rep from \* to end of row. Turn.

Rep last 2 rows for pat until work from beg measures 3" [7.5 cm], ending on a 2nd row.

**Shape neck of Hood: 1st row:** (RS). Ch 2. Hdc2tog. Pat to last 2 sts. Hdc2tog. Turn. **31 (35)** sts.

Rep last row twice more. **27 (31)** sts at end of last row. PM at end of last row.

**Next row:** Work even in pat.

**Shape back of Hood: 1st row:** (RS). Pat across **11 (13)** sts. Hdc2tog. Work next st in pat. PM on last st just worked. Hdc2tog. Pat to end of row. Turn. **25 (29)** sts.

**2nd row:** Pat to 2 sts before marked st. Hdc2tog. Work next st in pat. Hdc2tog. Pat to end of row. Turn. **23 (27)** sts.

Rep last row 4 times more. **15 (19)** sts at end of last row. Fasten off.

Fold last row in half and sew back sem.

Overlap fronts of Hood at foundation row 1½" [4 cm]. Sew Hood around neck opening, matching Hood seam with center back neck edge.

## POCKET

With larger hook and MC, ch **22 (26)**.

**1st row:** (RS). 1 sc in 2nd ch from hook. \*1 dc in next ch. 1 sc in next ch. Rep from \* to end of chain. Turn. **21 (25)** sts.

**2nd row:** Ch 3. \*1 sc in next dc. 1 dc in next sc. Rep from \* to end of row. Turn.

**3rd row:** Ch 1. 1 sc in first dc. \*1 dc in next sc. 1 sc in next dc. Rep from \* to end of row. Turn. Rep last 2 rows for pat until work from beg measures 3" [7.5 cm], ending on a 2nd row.

**Shape sides: 1st row:** (RS). Ch 2. Hdc2tog. Pat to last 2 sts. Hdc2tog. Turn.

**2nd row:** Work even in pat. Rep last 2 rows **3 (4)** times more. **13 (15)** sts rem. Fasten off.

Try on Hoodie. Pin Pocket at comfortable height on center front.

Sew Pocket edges in position, leaving shaped sides open.

## EARS (make 2)

With smaller hook and A, ch 6.

**1st row:** (RS). 1 sc in 2nd ch from hook and each ch to end of chain. Turn. 5 sc.

**2nd row:** Ch 1. 1 sc in each sc to end of row. Turn.

**3rd row:** Ch 1. Sc2tog. 1 sc in each sc to end of row. Turn. 4 sts.

4th row. 1 sc in each of first 2 sc. Sc2tog. Turn. 3 sts.

**5th row:** Ch 1. Sc2tog. 1 sc in last sc. Turn. 2 sts.

**6th row:** Ch 1. Sc2tog. Fasten off.

## HORN

With smaller hook and MC, ch 10. Join with sl st to first ch to form a ring. PM for beg of rnd.

**1st rnd:** Ch 1. 1 sc in each ch around. Join A with sl st to first sc.

**2nd rnd:** With A, ch 1. 1 sc in each sc around. Join MC with sl st to first sc.

**3rd rnd:** With MC, ch 1. Sc2tog. 1 sc in each sc around. Join A with sl st to first st. 9 sts.

**4th rnd:** With A, ch 1. 1 sc in each st to last 2 sc. Sc2tog. Join MC with sl st to first sc. 8 sts.

Rep last 2 rnds 3 times more. 2 sts at end of last rnd.

**Next rnd:** With A, ch 1. Sc2tog. Fasten off.

Sew Ears to Hood, having straight edges facing each other as shown.  
Sew Horn between Ears.
