Patons® Kroy Sock FX™ (1.75 oz/50 g; 166 yds/152 m)

Copper Colors (57510)

2 balls

Sizes U.S C/2 (2.75) and U.S. D/3 (3.25 mm) crochet hooks **or size needed to obtain gauge.** 2 Susan Bates® Split-Lock stitch count markers.



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CROCHET I SKILL LEVEL: EASY

ABBREVIATIONS

Approx = Approximately

Beg = Beginning

Ch = Chain(s)

Cont = Continue

Dec = Decrease

Inc = Increas(e)(ing)

Rep = Repeat

Rnd = Round(s)

Sc = Single crochet

Sc2tog = Draw up a loop in each of next 2 stitches. Yoh and draw through all 3 loops on hook.

SI st = Slip stitch

Sp = Space

St(s) = Stitch(es)

Yoh = Yarn over hook

SIZE

One size to fit Adult.

GAUGE

22 sc and 24 rows = 4" [10 cm] with larger hook.

INSTRUCTIONS

Stem: With larger hook, ch 7. **1st row:** SI st in 2nd ch from hook. SI st in each ch to end of chain. **Do not** turn. 6 sI sts.

From this point, Beret is worked in a continuous spiral. **Do not** join at end of rnds. Move marker each rnd to mark first st.

Beret: 1st rnd: 6 sc in same sp as

last sl st. 6 sc

2nd rnd: Working *behind* stem, 2 sc in first sc, placing marker on first of these 2 sts for beg of rnd. 2 sc in each sc around. 12 sc.

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3rd rnd: *2 sc in next sc. 1 sc in next sc. Rep from * around. 18 sc. 4th rnd: *1 sc in next sc. 2 sc in next sc. 1 sc in next sc. Rep from * around. 24 sc.

5th rnd: *2 sc in next sc. 1 sc in each of next 3 sc. Rep from * around. 30 sc.

6th rnd: *1 sc in each of next 2 sc. 2 sc in next sc. 1 sc in each of next 2 sc. Rep from * around. 36 sc.

7th rnd: *2 sc in next sc. 1 sc in each of next 5 sc. Rep from * around. 42 sc.

8th rnd: *1 sc in each of next 3 sc. 2 sc in next sc. 1 sc in each of next 3 sc. Rep from * around. 48 sc.

9th rnd: *2 sc in next sc. 1 sc in each of next 7 sc. Rep from * around. 54 sc.

10th rnd: *1 sc in each of next 4 sc. 2 sc in next sc. 1 sc in each of next 4 sc. Rep from * around. 60 sc.

11th rnd: *2 sc in next sc. 1 sc in each of next 9 sc. Rep from * around. 66 sc.

12th rnd: *1 sc in each of next 5 sc. 2 sc in next sc. 1 sc in each of next 5 sc. Rep from * around. 72 sc. Cont as established, alternating placement of increases and inc 6 sts each rnd to 204 sc.

Next 4 rnds: 1 sc in each sc around.

Dec as follows:

1st rnd: *1 sc in each of next 16 sc. Sc2tog. 1 sc in each of next 16 sc. Rep from * around. 198 sc.

2nd rnd: *Sc2tog. 1 sc in each of next 31 sc. Rep from * around. 192 sc.

3rd rnd: *1 sc in each of next 15 sc. Sc2tog. 1 sc in each of next 15 sc. Rep from * around. 186 sc.

4th rnd: *Sc2tog. 1 sc in each of next 29 sc. Rep from * around. 180 sc.

5th rnd: *1 sc in each of next 14 sc. Sc2tog. 1 sc in each of next 14 sc. Rep from * around. 174 sc.

6th rnd: *Sc2tog. 1 sc in each of next 27 sc. Rep from * around. 168 sc.

7th rnd: *1 sc in each of next 13 sc. Sc2tog. 1 sc in each of next 13 sc. Rep from * around. 162 sc.

8th rnd: *Sc2tog. 1 sc in each of next 25 sc. Rep from * around. 156 sc.

9th rnd: *1 sc in each of next 12 sc. Sc2tog. 1 sc in each of next 12 sc. Rep from * around. 150 sc.

10th rnd: *Sc2tog. 1 sc in each of next 23 sc. Rep from * around. 144 sc.

11th rnd: *1 sc in each of next 11 sc. Sc2tog. 1 sc in each of next 11 sc. Rep from * around. 138 sc. 12th rnd: *Sc2tog. 1 sc in each of next 21 sc. Rep from * around. 132 sc.

13th rnd: *1 sc in each of next 10 sc. Sc2tog. 1 sc in each of next 10 sc. Rep from * around. 126 sc. 14th rnd: *Sc2tog. 1 sc in each of next 19 sc. Rep from * around. 120 sc.

15th rnd: *1 sc in each of next 9 sc. Sc2tog. 1 sc in each of next 9 sc. Rep from * around. 114 sc.

Place second marker at end of last rnd.

Change to smaller hook.

Next rnd: 1 sc in each sc around. Rep last rnd until work from 2nd marker measures 1" [2.5 cm]. Join last rnd with sl st to first sc. Fasten off.
