



 KNIT | SKILL LEVEL: **BEGINNER**

### MEASUREMENTS

Approx 46" x 58" [117 x 147.5 cm].

### GAUGE

9 sts and 12 rows = 4" [10 cm] in  
Checkerboard Pattern.

### INSTRUCTIONS

Checkerboard Pat (multiple of 10 + 4).

**1st to 6th rows:** K2. \*K5. P5. Rep from \* to last 2 sts. K2.

**7th to 12th rows:** K2. \*P5. K5. Rep from \* to last 2 sts. K2.

Rep 1st to 12th rows for Checkerboard Pat.

Cast on 104 sts. **Do not** join. Working back and forth across needle in rows, proceed as follows:

Knit 3 rows (garter st), noting first row is WS.

Proceed in Checkerboard Pat until work from beg measures approx 57" [144 cm], ending on a 12th row of pat. Knit 3 rows (garter st).

Cast off knitwise (WS).

### **MATERIALS**

**Bernat® Blanket™** (10.3 oz/300 g; 220 yds/201 m) or (5.3 oz/150g; 108 yds/98 m)  
Olive (10241) or Pine Bough (86242) **910 yds/827 m or 4 (9) balls**

Size U.S. 13 (9 mm) circular knitting needle 36" [90 cm] long **or size needed to obtain gauge.**

**Approx** = Approximately

**Beg** = Beginning

**K** = Knit

**St(s)** = Stitch(es)

**P** = Purl

**Pat** = Pattern

**Rep** = Repeat

**WS** = Wrong side
