What you will need:

Red Heart® Hopscotch™: 1 ball 7953 Waterslide

Susan Bates® Circular Knitting Needle: 4.5mm [US 7] 16" (40.6 cm)

Susan Bates® Double Pointed Needles: One set 4.5mm [US 7]

Stitch marker, yarn needle

GAUGE: 16 sts = 4'' (10 cm);20 rounds = 4" (10 cm) in ribbing, slightly stretched. CHECK YOUR GAUGE. Use any size needles to obtain the gauge.

Easy Knit Rib Hat

Thanks to the stretchy nature of the rib stitch, this hat should fit most heads!

Fits most adults.

Hat circumference (slightly stretched): 18" (45.7 cm)

HAT

Cast on 80 sts. Join into the round, being careful not to twist sts, and place marker at beginning of round.

Round 1: *Knit 2, purl 2; repeat from * to end. Work in Knit 2, Purl 2 ribbing until hat measures 10" (25 cm) from cast on.

Shape Crown

Note: Change to double pointed needles when work is too small for circular needle.

Round 1: *Knit 2, purl 2 together (dec 1 st); repeat from * to end - 60 sts.

Rounds 2-4: *Knit 2, purl 1; repeat from * to end.

Round 5: *K2tog, purl 1; repeat from * to end - 40 sts.

Round 6: *Knit 1, purl 1; repeat from * to end. Round 7: *K2tog; repeat from * to end - 20 sts.

Round 8: Knit.

Round 9: *K2tog; repeat from * to end - 10 sts.

Cut yarn, leaving a long tail.

FINISHING

With yarn needle, weave yarn through remaining sts; gather sts up firmly and secure. To wear, fold brim up.

Abbreviations

dec = decreasing; **k2tog** = knit the next 2 sts together; mm = millimeters; st(s) = stitch(es); * = repeat whatever follows the * as indicated.
