

BERNAT GARTER RIPPLE STRIPES KNIT BABY BLANKET | KNIT



MATERIALS

Bernat[®] **Baby Blanket**[™] (10.5 oz/300 g; 220 yds/201 m)

Main Color (MC) Vanilla (04008) 1 ball Contrast A Seafoam (04736) 1 ball

Size U.S. 11 (8 mm) circular knitting needle 36" [91.5 cm] long or size needed to obtain gauge.



KNIT I SKILL LEVEL: EASY

ABBREVIATIONS

Approx = Approximately **Cont** = Continue(ity)

K = Knit

K2tog = Knit next 2 stitches

together

Pat = Pattern **Rep** = Repeat **RS** = Right side **St(s)** = Stitch(es) **Yo** = Yarn over

MEASUREMENTS

Approx 38" x 41" [96.5 x 104 cm].

GAUGE

7 sts and 14 rows = 4'' [10 cm] in garter st.

INSTRUCTIONS

Stripe Pat

**With MC, work 4 rows.

With A, work 4 rows.

With MC, work 4 rows.

With A, work 4 rows.

With MC, work 16 rows.

With A, work 4 rows.

With MC, work 4 rows.

With A, work 4 rows.

With MC, work 4 rows.**

With A, work 16 rows.

Work from ** to ** once more.

With A, work 4 rows.

These 116 rows form Stripe Pat.

With MC, cast on 80 sts. Do not

join.

Working back and forth across needle in rows, proceed as follows:

1st row: (RS). Knit. 2nd row: Knit.

3rd row: K4. *(K2tog) 4 times. (yo. K1) 8 times. (K2tog) 4 times. Rep

from * to last 4 sts. K4.

4th row: Knit.

These 4 rows form Garter Ripple

Pat.

Cont in Garter Ripple Pat, keeping cont of Stripe Pat, until all

116 rows are complete.

With A, knit 1 row. Cast off knitwise.
