



MATERIALS

Patons® Classic Wool Worsted™ (3.5 oz/100 g; 210 yds/192 m)

- Contrast A** Navy (77110) **1 ball**
- Contrast B** Seafoam (77219) **1 ball**
- Contrast C** Pumpkin (77605) **1 ball**
- Contrast D** Yellow (77615) **1 ball**
- Contrast E** Chestnut Brown (00231) **1 ball**

Size U.S. 7 (4.5 mm) knitting needles **or size needed to obtain gauge.**
20" [51 cm] square pillow form. 4 buttons.

INTERMEDIATE

MEASUREMENT

Approx 20" [51 cm] square.

GAUGE

20 sts and 26 rows = 4" [10 cm] in stocking stitch.

21½ sts and 24 rows = 4" [10 cm] in Fair Isle pat.

INSTRUCTIONS

FRONT

Note: When working from chart, carry color not in use loosely across WS of work, but never more than 5 sts. When it must pass over more than 5 sts, weave it over and under the color not in use at center point of sts it passes over.

With A, cast on 96 sts. Work chart to end of chart, *reading rows from right to left.* Cast off knitwise. Chart is shown on page 2.

BACK

Bottom Half:

**With A, cast on 90 sts.

1st and 2nd rows: *K1. P1. Rep from * to end of row.

3rd and 4th rows: *P1. K1. Rep from * to end of row.

Rep last 4 rows for pat until piece measures approx 9" [23 cm], ending on a WS row.**

Next row: (RS). *K2. P2. Rep from * to last 2 sts. K2.

Next row: *P2. K2. Rep from * to last 2 sts. P2.

Rep last 2 rows for (K2. P2) ribbing 4 times more.

Cast off in pat (RS).

Top Half:

Work from ** to ** as given for Bottom Half.

Button band

1st row: (RS). *K2. P2. Rep from * to last 2 sts. K2.

2nd row: *P2. K2. Rep from * to last 2 sts. P2.

Rep last 2 rows once more.

Buttonhole row: (K2. P2) 3 times.

Cast off 4 sts. Pat across next 16 sts. Cast off 4 sts. Pat across next 18 sts. Cast off 4 sts. Pat across next 16 sts. Cast off 4 sts.

Pat to end of row.

Next row: Work in (K2. P2) ribbing, casting on 4 sts over cast off sts.

Work 4 rows (K2. P2) ribbing.

Cast off in pat (RS).

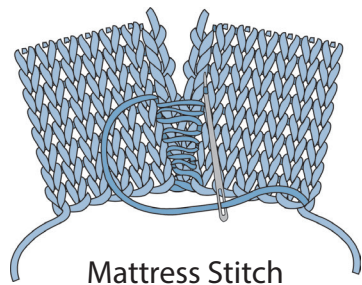


FINISHING

Pin pieces to measurements. Cover with a damp cloth, leaving cloth to dry.

Overlap Back pieces to match Front, with ribbed sections in center to create opening to insert pillow form. Sew outer edge seams.

With WS of Front and Back tog, sew side seams using mattress st. Sew on buttons to correspond with buttonholes.
