Celtic Cables and Ribs (to knit)

SIZES

Bust measurement

Small: 30-32 ins [76-81.5 cm]

Medium: 34-36 ins [86.5- 91.5 cm]

Large: 38-40 ins [96.5-101.5 cm]

Extra-Large: 42-44 ins [106.5-112 cm]

Finished bust

Small: 37½ ins [95 cm]

Medium: 40 ins [101.5 cm]

Large: 42 ins [106.5 cm]

Extra-Large: 46 ins [117 cm]

TENSION

20 sts and 26 rows = 4 ins [10 cm] with 2 strands of yarn in rib pat.

MATERIALS

Patons® Grace (50 g/1.75 oz)

Sizes: **S (M-L-XL):** 14 (15-16-17) balls

Size 5 mm (U.S. 8) knitting needles **or size needed to obtain tension.** Cable needle. Size 4 mm (U.S. G or 6) crochet hook.

ABBREVIATIONS

C6B = slip next 3 sts onto cable needle and leave at back of work. K3, then K3 from cable needle.

C6F = slip next 3 sts onto cable needle and leave at front of work. K3, then K3 from cable needle.

T5B = slip next 2 sts onto cable needle and leave at back of work. K3, then P2 from cable needle.

T5F = slip next 3 sts onto cable needle and leave at front of work. P2, then K3 from cable needle.

T4B = slip next st onto cable needle and leave at back of work. K3, then P1 from cable needle.

INSTRUCTIONS

The instructions are written for smallest size. If changes are necessary for larger sizes, the instructions will be written thus ().

PANEL PAT (worked over 31 sts)

1st row: (RS). P3. K3. (P4. C6F) twice. P5.

2nd row: K5. (P6. K4) twice. P3. K3.

3rd row: P3. (T5F. T5B) twice. T5F. P3.

4th row: K3. P3. (K4. P6) twice. K5.

5th row: P5. (C6B. P4) twice. K3. P3.

6th row: As 4th row.

7th row: P3. (T5B. T5F) twice. T5B. P3.

8th row: As 2nd row.

These 8 rows form Panel Pat.

FRONT

With 2 strands of yarn, cast on 97 (103-109-121) sts.

1st row: *K1. P1. Rep from * to last st. K1.

Rep last row once more.

Proceed in rib and side seed st pat as follows:

1st row: (RS). K1. P1. K1 (4-1-1). (P3. K3) 6 (6-7-8) times. (P4. K6) twice. P5. (K3. P3) 5 (5-6-7) times. K1 (4-1-1). P1. K1.

2nd row: K1. P1. K4 (1-4-4). (P3. K3) 4 (5-5-6) times. P3. K5. (P6. K4) twice. (P3. K3) 6 (6-7-8) times. P0 (3-0-0). K1. P1. K1.

Proceed in Panel Pat and side seed st pat as follows:

1st row: (RS). K1. P1. K1 (4-1-1). (P3. K3) 5 (5-6-7) times. Work 1st row of Panel Pat. (K3. P3) 5 (5-6-7) times. K1 (4-1-1). P1. K1.

2nd row: K1. P1. K4 (1-4-4). (P3. K3) 4 (5-5-6) times. P3. Work 2nd row of Panel Pat. (P3. K3) 5 (5-6-7) times. P0 (3-0-0). K1. P1. K1.

Panel Pat is now in position.

Cont in pat, keeping cont of Panel Pat, until work from beg measures 2½ ins [6 cm]. Place a marker at each end of needle on last row.

Proceed in pat as follows:

Next row: (RS). K3 (0-3-3). (P3. K3) 5 (6-6-7) times. Work appropriate row of Panel Pat. (K3. P3) 5 (6-6-7) times. K3 (0-3-3).

Next row: P3 (0-3-3). (K3. P3) 5 (6-6-7) times. Work appropriate row of Panel Pat. (P3. K3) 5 (6-6-7) times. P3 (0-3-3).

Rep last 2 rows until work from beg measures approx 16 ins [40.5 cm], ending with a 2nd row of Panel Pat.

Shape armholes: Keeping cont of pat, cast off 7 (4-7-7) sts beg next 2 rows. 83 (95-95-107) sts. Dec 1 st at each end of needle on next 4 rows, thus ending with 8th row of Panel Pat. 75 (87-87-99) sts.

Proceed as follows:

Work 2 rows even in pat.

Next row: Pat 22 (28-28-34) sts. P3. K3. P3. T4B. K3. P3. T4B. T5F. P3. Pat to end of row.

Next row: Pat 22 (28-28-34) sts. (K3. P3) twice. K7. (P3. K3) twice. Pat to end of row.

(K3. P3) rib is now in position.

Cont in (K3. P3) rib only, proceed as follows:

Front opening: Next row: Pat across 36 (42-42-48) sts. P2tog. **Turn.** Leave rem 37 (43-43-49) sts on a spare needle.

Work 5 rows even in (K3. P3) rib pat.

Proceed as follows:

1st row: (RS). (Eyelet row). Pat to last 3 sts. yrn. P2tog. P1.

Work 7 rows even.

9th row: As 1st row.

Work 4 rows even.

Neck shaping: Next row: (WS). Cast off 10 (12-12-12) sts. Pat to end of row.

Dec 1 st at neck edge on next 6 (6-6-10) rows. 21 (25-25-27) sts.

Cont even until armhole measures $6\frac{1}{2}$ (7-8- $8\frac{1}{2}$) ins [16.5 (18-20.5-21.5) cm], ending with RS facing for next row.

Shoulder shaping: Cast off 10 (12-12-13) sts beg next row. Work 1 row even. Cast off rem 11 (13-13-14) sts.

Join yarn to rem sts on spare needle and rib to end of row.

Keeping cont of rib pat, work 5 rows even.

Proceed as follows:

1st row: (RS). (Eyelet row). P1. P2tog. yrn. Pat to end of row.

Work 7 rows even.

9th row: As 1st row.

Work 5 rows even.

Neck shaping: Next row: (RS). Cast off 10 (12-12-12) sts. Pat to end of row.

Dec 1 st at neck edge on next 6 (6-6-10) rows. 21 (25-25-27) sts.

Cont even until armhole measures $6\frac{1}{2}$ (7-8- $8\frac{1}{2}$) ins [16.5 (18-20.5-21.5) cm], ending with WS facing for next row.

Shoulder shaping: Cast off 10 (12-12-13) sts beg next row. Work 1 row even. Cast off rem 11 (13-13-14) sts.

BACK

With 2 strands of yarn, cast on 93 (99-105-117) sts.

1st row: (RS). *K1. P1. Rep from * to last st. K1. Rep last row once more.

Proceed in rib and side seed st pat as follows:

1st row: (RS). K1. P1. K1 (4-1-1). *P3. K3. Rep from * to last 6 (3-6-6) sts. P3 (0-3-3). K1. P1. K1.

2nd row: K1. P1. K4 (1-4-4). *P3. K3. Rep from * to last 3 (6-3-3) sts. P0 (3-0-0). K1. P1. K1.

Rep last 2 rows until work from beg measures $2\frac{1}{2}$ ins [6 cm]. Place a marker at each end of needle on last row.

Proceed in (K3. P3) rib pat as follows:

Next row: (RS). K3 (0-3-3). *P3. K3. Rep from * to last 0 (3-0-0) sts. P0 (3-0-0).

Next row: K0 (3-0-0). *P3. K3. Rep from * to last 3 (0-3-3) sts. P3 (0-3-3).

Rep last 2 rows until work from beg measures same length as Front to beg of armhole shaping, ending with RS facing for next row.

Shape armholes: Keeping cont of pat, cast off 7 (4-7-7) sts beg next 2 rows. 79 (91-91-103) sts.

Dec 1 st at each end of needle on next 4 rows. 71 (83-83-95) sts.

Cont even in pat until armhole measures $6\frac{1}{2}$ (7-8- $8\frac{1}{2}$) ins [16.5 (18-20.5-21.5) cm], ending with RS facing for next row.

Shoulder shaping: Cast off 10 (12-12-13) sts beg next 2 rows, then cast off 11 (13-13-14) sts beg following 2 rows. Cast off rem 29 (33-33-41) sts.

SLEEVES

With 2 strands of yarn, cast on 60 (66-72-72) sts.

Next row: (RS). *K1. P1. Rep from * to end of row.

Next row: *P1. K1. Rep from * to end of row.

Proceed as follows:

1st row: *K3. P3. Rep from * to end of row.

This row forms (K3. P3) ribbing pat.

Cont in (K3. P3) ribbing pat, inc 1 st at each end of 5th row, then following 6th row. 64 (70-76-76) sts, taking inc sts into rib pat.

Work 11 rows even.

Shape cap: Cast off 4 sts beg next 2 rows. Dec 1 st at each end of next 10 rows. Cast off 3 sts beg next 2 rows. Cast off rem 30 (36-42-42) sts.

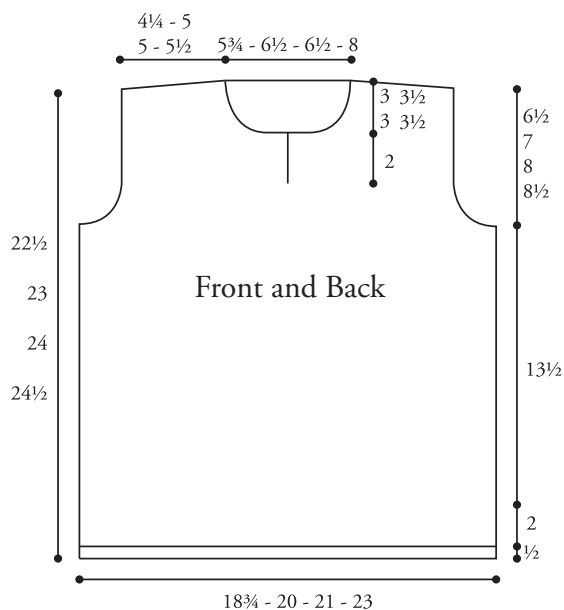
FINISHING

Pin garment pieces to measurements and cover with a damp cloth allowing cloth to dry.

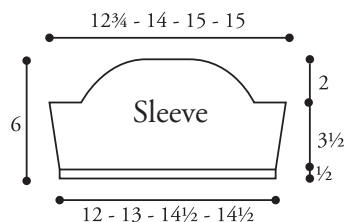
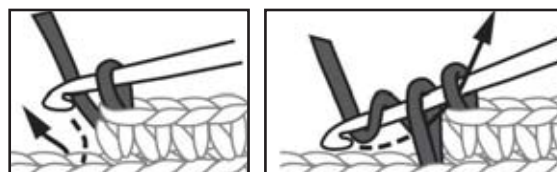
Sew shoulder seams. With RS of work facing and 2 strands of yarn, work 1 row of single crochet around neck edge, and front opening (see diagram).

With 2 strands of yarn, crochet a chain 36 ins [90 cm] long. Fasten off. Thread through eyelet holes as illustrated. Knot ends.

Sew in sleeves. Beg at marked rows at side edges, sew side and sleeve seams.
