## PATONS® CANADIANA

CHILD: RAGLAN SLEEVE JACKET

NEEDLES: Sizes 4 mm (U.S. 6) and 4.5 mm (U.S. 7) knitting needles or size needed to obtain tension.

### NOTIONS

Separating zipper 14 (16-16-16-18-18) " [35.5 (40.5-40.5-40.5-45.5-45.5) cm] long.

TENSION: 20 sts and 26 rows = 4" [10 cm] in stocking st with larger needles.

**Note:** Check your tension by making a test swatch and adjusting your needle size, if necessary, to obtain the tension quoted in the pattern. Inaccurate tension may result in an item too large or too small.

## STITCH GLOSSARY

**Alt** = Alternate(ing).

**Beg** = Beginning.

**Cont** = Continue(ity).

**Dec** = Decrease(ing).

**Inc(s)** = Increase 1 stitch by knitting into front and back of next stitch.

**K** = Knit.

**K2tog** = Knit next 2 stitches together.

**P** = Purl.

**Pat** = Pattern.

**P2tog** = Purl next 2 stitches together.

**P2togtbl** = Purl next 2 stitches together through back loops.

**Rep** = Repeat.

**RS** = Right side.

**Ssk** = Slip next 2 stitches knitwise one at a time. Pass them back onto left-hand needle, then knit through back loops together.

**St(s)** = Stitch(es).

**WS** = Wrong side.

CHILD: RAGLAN SLEEVE JACKET

**INSTRUCTIONS:** *The instructions are written for smallest size. If changes are necessary for larger sizes the instructions will be written thus ( ). Numbers for each size are shown in the same color throughout the pattern. When only one number is given in black, it applies to all sizes.*

### STRIPED VERSION

**Stripe Pat** (worked in stocking st).

With C, work 2 rows.

With A, work 2 rows.

With B, work 2 rows.

\*With MC, work 3 rows.

With A, work 1 row.\*

Rep from \* to \* once more.

With MC, work 3 rows.

With B, work 2 rows.

With C, work 2 rows.

With A, work 2 rows.

\*\*With MC, work 3 rows.

With C, work 1 row.\*\*

Rep from \*\* to \*\* once more.

With MC, work 3 rows.

These 34 rows form Stripe Pat.

### BACK

With MC and smaller needles, cast on **62** (70-74-78-82-90) sts.

**1st row:** (RS). \*K2. P2. Rep from \* to last 2 sts. K2.

**2nd row:** \*P2. K2. Rep from \* to last 2 sts. P2.

Rep last 2 rows (K2. P2) ribbing for **2** (2-2-2½-2½-2½)" [**5** (5-5-6-6-6) cm], ending with a 2nd row and inc **3** (1-1-3-3-1) st(s) evenly across last row.

**65** (71-75-81-85-91) sts.

Change to larger needles and proceed in stocking st until work from beg measures **10** (11-12-12½-13½-14½)" [**25.5** (28-30.5-32-34.5-37) cm], ending with a purl row.

Proceed in Stripe Pat and cont as follows:

**Shape raglans:** Keeping cont of Stripe Pat, cast off **2** (2-2-3-3-3) sts beg next 2 rows. **61** (67-71-75-79-85) sts.

**1st row:** (RS). K2. ssk. Knit to last 4 sts. K2tog. K2.

**2nd row:** Purl.

Rep last 2 rows **18** (19-21-22-24-26) times more.

**23** (27-27-29-29-31) sts.

Cast off.

### LEFT FRONT

With MC and smaller needles, cast on **31** (35-35-39-39-43) sts.

**1st row:** (RS). \*K2. P2. Rep from \* to last 3 sts. K3.

**2nd row:** K1. \*P2. K2. Rep from \* to last 2 sts. P2.

Rep last 2 rows for **2** (2-2-2½-2½-2½)" [**5** (5-5-6-6-6) cm], ending on a 2nd row and inc **1** (0-2-1-3-2) st(s) evenly across last row. **32** (35-37-40-42-45) sts.

Change to larger needles and proceed in stocking st until work from beg measures **10** (11-12-12½-13½-14½)" [**25.5** (28-30.5-32-34.5-37) cm], ending with a purl row.

Proceed in Stripe Pat and cont as follows:

**Shape raglan: 1st row:** (RS). Keeping cont of Stripe Pat, cast off **2** (2-2-3-3-3) sts. **30** (33-35-37-39-42) sts.

**2nd row:** Purl 1 row.

**3rd row:** (RS). K2. ssk. Knit to end of row.

**4th row:** Purl.

Rep last 2 rows **10** (11-12-13-15-16) times more, then 1st row once. **18** (20-21-22-22-24) sts.

**Shape neck: Next row:** (WS). Cast off **4** (6-5-6-6-6) sts. Purl to end of row.

**Next row:** K2. ssk. Knit to last 2 sts. K2tog (neck edge).

**Next row:** Purl.

Rep last 2 rows **4** (4-5-5-5-6) times more. 4 sts.

**Next row:** (RS). K2. ssk.

**Next row:** P3.

**Next row:** K1. ssk.

**Next row:** P2.

**Next row:** ssk. Fasten off.

### RIGHT FRONT

With MC and smaller needles, cast on **31** (35-35-39-39-43) sts.

**1st row:** (RS). K3. \*P2. K2. Rep from \* to end of row.

**2nd row:** \*P2. K2. Rep from \* to last 3 sts. P2. K1.

Rep last 2 rows for **2** (2-2-2½-2½-2½)" [**5** (5-5-6-6-6) cm], ending with a 2nd row and inc **1** (0-2-1-3-2) st(s) evenly across last row. **32** (35-37-40-42-45) sts.

Change to larger needles and proceed in stocking st until work from beg measures same length as Left Front to raglan shaping, ending with a purl row.

Proceed in Stripe Pat for 1 row, then cont in pat as follows:

**Shape raglan: 1st row:** (WS). Keeping cont of Stripe Pat, cast off **2** (2-2-3-3-3) sts beg next row. **30** (33-35-37-39-42) sts.

**2nd row:** (RS). Knit to last 4 sts. K2tog. K2.

**3rd row:** Purl.

Rep last 2 rows **10** (11-12-13-15-16) times more. **19** (21-22-23-23-25) sts.

**Shape neck: Next row:** (RS). Cast off **4** (6-5-6-6-6) sts. Knit to last 4 sts. K2tog. K2.

**Next row:** Purl.

**Next row:** ssk (neck edge). Knit to last 4 sts. K2tog. K2.

Rep last 2 rows **4** (4-5-5-5-6) times more. 4 sts.

**Next row:** Purl.

**Next row:** K2tog. K2.

**Next row:** P3.

**Next row:** K2tog. K1.

**Next row:** P2.

**Next row:** K2tog. Fasten off.

### SLEEVES

With MC and smaller needles, cast on **38** (38-42-42-46-46) sts.

Work **2** (2-2-2½-2½-2½)" [**5** (5-5-6-6-6) cm] in (K2. P2) ribbing as given for Back, ending with a 2nd row and inc 3 sts evenly across last row. **41** (41-45-45-49-49) sts.

Change to larger needles and work 6 rows in stocking st.

Inc 1 st each end of next and every following 4th row until there are **55** (61-65-71-75-81) sts.

Cont even until work from beg measures **7½** (9½-10½-11½-12½-14)" [**19** (24-26.5-29-32-35.5) cm], ending with a purl row.





### COLLAR

With MC and smaller needles, cast on 5 sts.

**1st row:** (WS). Knit.

**2nd row:** Inc 1 st in first st. Knit to last 2 sts. Inc 1 st in next st. K1 (place marker for inner edge).

Rep last 2 rows **9 (9-10-10-11-11)** times more. **25 (25-27-27-29-29)** sts.

Cont even in garter st (knit every row) until work from beg (when slightly stretched) measures **12½ (13-13-13½-14-14)" [32 (33-33-34.5-35.5-35.5)** cm], ending with a WS row.

**Next row:** K1. K2tog. Knit to last 3 sts. ssk. K1.

**Next row:** Knit.

Rep last 2 rows **9 (9-10-10-11-11)** times more. 5 sts. Cast off.

### FINISHING

Pin garment pieces to measurements and cover with damp cloth leaving cloth to dry.

Sew raglan seams. Sew side and sleeve seams.

**Zipper edging:** With RS facing, MC and smaller needles, pick up and knit **61 (65-69-75-79-83)** sts evenly up Right Front edge between cast on edge and neck edge. Knit 2 rows. Cast off knitwise (WS). Rep on Left Front edge picking up sts between neck edge and cast on edge.

Sew Collar in position, matching cast on and cast off edges of Collar to cast off sts at neck edge. Sew zipper in position under edging.

### PLAIN VERSION

Work as for Striped Version omitting all references to Stripe Pat.

Proceed in Stripe Pat and cont as follows:

**Shape raglans:** Keeping cont of Stripe Pat, cast off **2 (2-2-3-3-3)** sts beg next 2 rows. **51 (57-61-65-69-75)** sts.

**1st row:** (RS). K2. ssk. Knit to last 4 sts. K2tog. K2.

**2nd row:** P2. P2tog. Purl to last 4 sts. P2togtbl. P2.

**3rd row:** As 1st row.

**4th row:** Purl.

Rep last 4 rows **2 (4-4-4-4-5)** times more. **33 (27-31-35-39-39)** sts.

**1st row:** (RS). K2. ssk. Knit to last 4 sts. K2tog. K2.

**2nd row:** Purl.

Rep last 2 rows **12 (9-11-12-14-14)** times more. **7 (7-7-9-9-9)** sts. Cast off.
