



MATERIALS

Patons® Canadiana™ (3.5 oz/100 g; 205 yds/187 m)

Sizes	2/4 yrs	6/8 yrs	10/12	Lady	Man	
Main Color (MC) Med Teal (10744) or Dark Water Blue (10145) or Tangy (10628)	1	1	1	1	1	ball
Contrast A Tomato Red (10704) or Burnt Orange (10630) or Lime Juice (10712)	1	1	1	1	1	ball
Contrast B Pale Grey Mix (10046) or Fool's Gold (10610) or Grape Jelly (10307)	1	1	1	1	1	ball
Contrast C Tangy (10628) or Winter White (10006) or Fool's Gold (10610)	1	1	1	1	1	ball

Hat: Set of four sizes U.S. 6 (4 mm) and U.S. 7 (4.5 mm) double-pointed knitting needles **or size needed to obtain gauge.**

Mittens: Set of four sizes U.S. 5 (3.75 mm) and U.S. 6 (4 mm) double-pointed knitting needles **or size needed to obtain gauge.** Stitch holder.

ABBREVIATIONS:

Alt = Alternate(ing)

Beg = Beginning

Inc = Increase 1 stitch by knitting into front and back of next stitch

K = Knit

K2tog = Knit next two stitches together

Ssk = Slip next 2 stitches knitwise one at a time.

Pass them back onto left-hand needle, then knit through back loops together

KNIT | SKILL LEVEL: INTERMEDIATE

These 24 rnds form Stripe Pat.

MEASUREMENTS

Hat and Mittens: To fit head and hands of average size of child/adult **2/4 yrs (6/8 yrs-10/12 yrs-Lady-Man).**

GAUGE

Hat: 20 sts and 26 rows = 4"

[10 cm] with larger needles in stocking st.

Mittens: 22 sts and 28 rows = 4" [10 cm] with larger needles in stocking st.

INSTRUCTIONS

The instructions are written for smallest size. If changes are necessary for larger sizes the instructions will be written thus ().

HAT

With A: 4 rnds.

With MC: 4 rnds.

With B: 4 rnds

With MC: 4 rnds.

With C: 4 rnds.

With MC: 4 rnds.

With MC and set of 4 smaller double-pointed needles, cast on **80 (84-88-96-104)** sts.

Divide sts onto 3 needles: **27 (28-29-32-35)** on 1st needle, **27 (28-29-32-35)** on 2nd needle and **26 (28-30-32-34)** on 3rd needle. Join in rnd, placing marker on first st.

1st rnd: *K2. P2. Rep from * around.

Rep last rnd (K2. P2) ribbing until work from beg measures **4 (5-5-6-6)" [10 (12.5-12.5-15-15)** cm].

Change to set of larger double-pointed needles and knit in Stripe Pat until work from beg measures **6½ (7-7½-8-8½)" [16.5 (18-19-20.5-21.5) cm].

Size 6/8 only: Next row: Knit, dec 4 sts evenly around. 80 sts.

All sizes: Shape top: Keeping cont of Stripe Pat, proceed as follows:

1st rnd: *K2tog. K**16 (16-18-20-22)**, ssk. Rep from * around. **72 (72-80-88-96)** sts.

2nd and alt rnds: Knit.

3rd rnd: *K2tog. K14 (14-16-18-20). ssk. Rep from * around. 64 (64-72-80-88) sts.

5th rnd: *K2tog. K12 (12-14-16-18). ssk. Rep from * around. 56 (56-64-72-80) sts.

7th rnd: *K2tog. K10 (10-12-14-16). ssk. Rep from * around. 48 (48-56-64-72) sts.

9th rnd: *K2tog. K8 (8-10-12-14). ssk. Rep from * around. 40 (40-48-56-64) sts.

11th rnd: *K2tog. K6 (6-8-10-12). ssk. Rep from * around. 32 (32-40-48-56) sts.

13th rnd: *K2tog. K4 (4-6-8-10). ssk. Rep from * around. 24 (24-32-40-48) sts.

15th rnd: *K2tog. K2 (2-4-6-8). ssk. Rep from * around. 16 (16-24-32-40) sts.

16th rnd: Knit.

Sizes 10/12, Lady and Man only:

17th rnd: *K2tog. K(2-4-6). ssk. Rep from * around. (16-24-32) sts.

18th rnd: Knit.

Sizes Lady and Man only: 19th rnd:

*K2tog. K(2-4). ssk. Rep from *

around. (16-24) sts.

20th rnd: Knit.

Size Man only: 21st rnd: *K2tog.

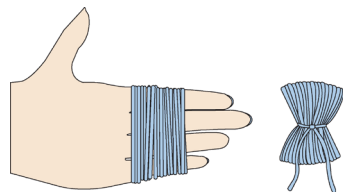
K2. ssk. Rep from * around. 16 sts.

22nd rnd: Knit.

All sizes: Break yarn leaving, a long end. Thread end through rem 16 sts. Draw up and fasten securely.**

Optional:

Pompom: Wind A around 4 fingers approx 80 times. Remove from fingers and tie tightly in center. Cut through each side of loops. Trim to a smooth round shape. Sew pompom to top of Hat.



MITTENS

RIGHT MITTEN

**With MC and set of 4 smaller double-pointed needles, cast on 28 (32-36-40-48) sts. Divide sts onto 3 needles: 14 (16-18-21-24) sts on 1st needle, 7 (8-9-10-12) sts on 2nd needle and 7 (8-9-11-12) sts on 3rd needle. Join in rnd, placing marker on first st.

1st rnd: *K2. P2. Rep from * around.

Rep last rnd of (K2. P2) ribbing for 1½ (2-2-2½-3)" [4 (5-5-6-7.5) cm].****

Size Lady only: Next rnd: Knit, inc 2 sts evenly around. 42 sts.

All sizes: Change to larger needles and knit 4 (5-6-6-7) rnds in Stripe Pat as given for Hat.**

Keeping cont of Stripe Pat, proceed as follows:

Shape thumb gusset: 1st rnd: K15 (17-19-22-25). Inc 1 st in each of next 2 sts. Knit to end of rnd.

2nd and alt rnds: Knit.

3rd rnd: K15 (17-19-22-25). Inc 1 st in next st. K2. Inc 1 st in next st. Knit to end of rnd.

5th rnd: K15 (17-19-22-25). Inc 1 st in next st. K4. Inc 1 st in next st. Knit to end of rnd. 34 (38-42-48-54) sts.

6th rnd: Knit.

Sizes 6/8, 10/12, Lady and Man only:

7th rnd: K(17-19-22-25). Inc 1 st in next st. K6. Inc 1 st in next st. Knit to end of rnd. (40-44-50-56) sts.

8th rnd: Knit.

Sizes 10/12, Lady and Man only:

9th rnd: K(19-22-25). Inc 1 st in next st.

K8. Inc 1 st in next st. Knit to end of rnd. (46-52-58) sts.

10th rnd: Knit.

Sizes Lady and Man only: 11th rnd:

K(22-25). Inc 1 st in next st. K10. Inc 1 st in next st. Knit to end of rnd. (54-60) sts.

12th rnd: Knit.

All sizes: Next rnd: K23 (27-31-36-39). Slip last 8 (10-12-14-14) sts onto st holder. Knit to end of rnd.

*****Next rnd:** Knit, casting on 2 sts over slipped sts. 28 (32-36-42-48) sts.

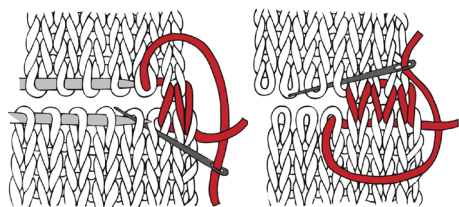
Keeping cont of Stripe Pat, knit in rnds until work after ribbing measures 3½ (4½-5½-6-6½)" [9 (11.5-14-15-16.5) cm].

Rearrange sts as follows: 14 (16-18-21- 24) sts on 1st needle. 7 (8-9-10-12) sts on 2nd needle and 7 (8-9-11-12) sts on 3rd needle.

Shape top: 1st rnd: 1st needle: K1. ssk. Knit to last 3 sts. K2tog. K1.
2nd needle: K1. ssk. Knit to end of needle. **3rd needle:** Knit to last 3 sts. K2tog. K1.

2nd rnd: Knit.
Rep last 2 rnds until 12 (12-16-18-20) sts rem. Graft 2 sets of 6 (6-8-9-10) sts tog.

Grafting



Thumb: Join appropriate yarn to base of thumb, pick up and knit 2 sts. K8 (10-12-14-14) from st holder. Divide these 10 (12-14-16-16) sts onto 3 needles.

Work in Stripe Pat until Thumb from pick up rnd measures 1 (1½-2-2¼-2½)" [2.5 (4-5-5.5-6) cm].

Next rnd: *K2tog. Rep from * around. 5 (6-7-8-8) sts.

Sizes Lady and Man only: Next rnd: *K2tog. Rep from * around. 4 sts.

All sizes: Break yarn, leaving a long end. Thread end through rem 5 (6-7-4-4) sts. Draw up and fasten securely.***

LEFT MITTEN

Work from ** to ** as given for Right Mitten.
Keeping cont of Stripe Pat, proceed as follows:

Shape thumb gusset: 1st rnd: K11 (13-15-18-21). Inc 1 st in each of next 2 sts. Knit to end of rnd.

2nd and alt rnds: Knit.

3rd rnd: K11 (13-15-18-21). Inc 1 st in next st. K2. Inc 1 st in next st. Knit to end of rnd.

5th rnd: K11 (13-15-18-21). Inc 1 st in next st. K4. Inc 1 st in next st. Knit to end of rnd. 34 (38-42-48-54) sts.

6th rnd: Knit.

Sizes 6/8, 10/12, Lady and Man only: 7th rnd: K(13-15-18-21). Inc 1 st in next st. K6. Inc 1 st in next st. Knit to end of rnd. (40-44-50-56) sts.

8th rnd: Knit.

Sizes 10/12, Lady and Man only: 9th rnd: K(15-18-21). Inc 1 st in next st. K8. Inc 1 st in next st. Knit to end of rnd. (46-52-58) sts.

10th rnd: Knit.

Sizes Lady and Man only: 11th rnd: K(18-21). Inc 1 st in next st. K10. Inc 1 st in next st. Knit to end of rnd. (54-60) sts.

Next rnd: Knit.

All sizes: Next rnd: K19 (23-27-32-35). Slip last 8 (10-12-14-14) sts onto st holder. Knit to end of rnd.

Work from *** to *** as given for Right Mitten.
