What you will need:

RED HEART® Dreamy Stripes™: 2 (2, 3) balls 9381 Caribbean

Susan Bates® Knitting Needles: 6.5mm [US 10½]

Yarn needle

GAUGE: 15 sts = 4" [10 cm];
20 rows = 4" [10 cm] in
pattern stitch. **CHECK YOUR
GAUGE.** Use any size needles
to obtain the gauge.

Pleasing Eyelet Shawl

This shawl is written in multiple sizes so you can make the size that suits you the best! The eyelet lace pattern adds a delicate touch to Dreamy Stripes, and the yarn does all the color work for you.

Shawl measures 16 (20, 29)" [40 (51, 74) cm] wide x 50 (54, 60)" [127 (137, 152) cm] long.

Directions are for size Small; changes for sizes Medium and Large are in parentheses.

NOTE

When working the double yo on wrong side, purl first yo through front loop and knit second yo through back loop. First and last 3 sts are worked in Garter st to create a border.

SPECIAL ABBREVIATIONS

ssk: (1 st decrease) Slip next two sts knitwise to right needle, insert point of left needle through front of sts, knit these sts together through back loop.

SHAWL

Cast on 60 (76, 108) sts.

Knit 8 rows.

Row 1 (Right Side): K3, k3, *k4, k2tog, [yo] twice, ssk, k4, k2tog, [yo] twice, ssk; repeat from * to last 6 sts, k6.

Row 2 And All Wrong Side Rows: K3, purl to last 3 sts, k3.

Row 3: K3, k3, *k2, k2tog, [yo] twice, ssk, k4, k2tog, [yo] twice, ssk, k2; repeat from * to last 6 sts, k6.

Row 5: K3, k3, *k2tog, [yo] twice, ssk, k4, k2tog, [yo] twice, ssk, k4; repeat from * to last 6 sts, k2tog, yo, k4.

Row 7: K3, k1, *k2tog, [yo] twice, ssk, k4; repeat from * to last 8 sts, k2tog, [yo] twice, ssk, k1, k3.

Row 8: K3, purl to last 3 sts, k3.

Repeat Rows 1-8 until piece measures 49 (53, 59)" [124.5 (134.5, 150) cm] from beginning, end with a wrong side row.

Knit 8 rows.

Bind off. Weave in ends.

Abbreviations

cm = centimeters; **k** = knit; **k2tog** = knit 2 sts together; **mm** = millimeters; **p** = purl; **st(s)** = stitch(es); **yo** = yarn over; **[]** = work directions in brackets the number of times specified; *** or **** = repeat whatever follows the * or ** as indicated.
