## What you will need:

RED HEART® With Love®: 2 skeins each of 1805 Bluebell A, 1938 Beachy B, 1502 Iced Aqua C, and 1308 Tan D.

Susan Bates® Crochet Hook: 4.5 mm [US H-8] (used for Round 2 of Border only) and 6 mm [US J-10]

Yarn needle

GAUGE: With larger hook, one pattern repeat =  $4\frac{1}{2}$ " (11.5 cm); f4 rows =  $2\frac{3}{4}$ " (12 cm). CHECK YOUR GAUGE. Use any size hook to obtain the gauge given.

# Rippling Waters Throw

This soft and cozy throw features a beautiful, timeless ripple pattern. Crochet it in colors to accent any room in your home or for a thoughtful gift. It will be enjoyed for many years to come!

Throw measures 47" x 57" (119.5 x 145 cm)

#### **Special Abbreviations**

shell: 3 dc in same st or space.

### **THROW**

With larger hook and A, ch 200.

Row 1 (right side): Working in back bumps of ch sts, sc in 2nd ch from hook, [skip next ch, shell in next ch, skip next ch, sc in next ch] twice, \*shell in next ch, sc in next ch, skip next ch, shell in next ch, skip next ch, sc in next ch, skip next ch, skip next ch, skip next 2 ch, sc in next ch, skip next 2 ch, shell in next ch, skip next ch, sc in next ch, shell in next ch, skip next ch, sc in next ch, skip next ch, sc in next ch; repeat from \* across, ending last repeat at \*\*, skip next ch, sc in last ch; turn.

Row 2: Slip st to center dc of next shell, ch 1, sc in first dc, \*shell in next sc, sc in center dc of next shell, shell in next sc, sc in first dc of next shell, shell in next dc, sc in next dc, [shell in next sc, sc in center dc of next shell] twice, ch 1, sc in center dc of next shell; repeat from \* across; turn.

Row 3: Repeat Row 2.

Row 4: Slip st to center dc of next shell, ch 1, sc in first dc, \*ch 1, dc in next sc. ch 1, sc in center dc of next shell, ch 1, dc in next sc, ch 1, (sc, ch 2, sc) in center dc of next shell, ch 1, dc in next sc. ch 1, sc in center dc of next shell, ch 1, dc in next sc, ch 1, sc in center dc of next shell\*, ch 1, sc in center dc of next shell\*, ch 1, sc in center dc of next shell; repeat from \* across, ending last repeat at \*\*. turn. Fasten off.

Row 5: With right side facing, join B with a slip st in first ch-1 space, ch 1, sc in first ch-1 space, \*shell in next ch-1 space, sc in next ch-1 space. Shell in next ch-1 space, sc in next sc, shell in next ch-2 space, sc in next sc, [shell in next ch-1 space, sc in next ch-1 space] twice\*\*, ch 1, skip next (center) ch-1

space, sc in next ch-1 space; repeat from \* across, ending last repeat at \*\*; turn.

Row 6: Repeat Row 4.

Rows 7-8: With C, repeat Rows 5-6.

Rows 9-10: With B, repeat Rows 5-6. Rows 11-12: With C, repeat Rows 5-6.

Row 13: With D, repeat Row 5.

Rows 14-16: Repeat Rows 2-4. Fasten off.

Row 17: With A, repeat Row 5.

Rows 18-20: Repeat Rows 2-4. Fasten off. Rows 21-80: Repeat Rows 5-20 (3 times),

then repeat rows 5-16 once.

#### **Border**

**Round 1:** With right side facing, join **C** with a slip st in top right corner sc, ch 1, (sc, ch 2, sc) in same sc; working across top edge, \*sc in each of next 8 sts and ch-1 spaces, (sc, ch 2, sc) in next ch-2 sp at point, sc in each of next 8 sts and ch-1 spaces\*\*, skip next (sc. ch-1 space, sc); repeat from \* across. ending last repeat at \*\*, (sc, ch 2, sc) in last corner sc; working in row-end sts across left side edge, sc evenly across, working 6 sc across first 4-row stripe, then work 7 sc across each 4-row stripe and 3 sc across each 2-row stripe, ending with (sc, ch 2, sc) in end corner ch (131 sc across side); working across bottom edge, [sc in next ch-1 space, sc in next ch] 3 times, sc in next ch-1 space, \*\*\*ch 1, skip next 3 ch, [sc in next ch-1 space, sc in next ch] 3 times\*\*\*\*, 2 sc in next ch-2 space, (sc, ch 2, sc) in next ch (at point), 2 sc in next ch-2 space, [sc in next ch, sc in next ch-1 space] 3 times, (9 sc on each side of ch-2 space at points); repeat from \*\*\* across, ending last repeat at \*\*\*\*, (sc, ch 2, sc) in corner ch, working across right side edge, sc evenly across, working 6 sc across first 4-row stripe, then work 7 sc across each 4-row stripe and 3 sc across each 2-row stripe; join with a slip st in first sc. Fasten off **C**.

Round 2: With right side facing and smaller hook, join B with a slip st in first sc to the left of any ch-2 space, \*ch 1, slip st in next sc; repeat from \* across to next corner, ch 2, (slip st, ch 3, slip st) in next ch-2 space, ch 2, slip st in next sc; repeat from \* around; join with a slip st in first sc. Fasten off.

Weave in ends. With wrong side facing, block lightly.

#### **ABBREVIATIONS**

A, B, C, D = color A, B, C, D; ch = chain; dc = double crochet; sc = single crochet; st(s) = stitch(es); () = work directions in parentheses into same st; [] = work directions in brackets the number of times specified; \* = repeat whatever follows the \* as indicated.
