Woven Cable Scarf

This interesting cable scarf pattern is edged with a Seed Stitch border and finished off with a button that simply slips between the cables (no buttonhole needed). The bulky yarn knits up quickly and is shaded for an ombré effect.

What you will need:

RED HEART® Boutique Infinity™:
2 balls 9400 Thunder

Susan Bates® Knitting Needles:
9mm [US 13]

Cable needle, yarn needle, one
1½" (37 mm) long Abalone shell
button, sewing needle and thread

GAUGE: 12 sts = 4" [10 cm]; 16
rows = 4" [10 cm] in Seed St and
17 sts = 4" [10 cm]; 16 rows = 4"
[10 cm] in Woven Cable Pattern.
**CHECK YOUR GAUGE. Use any
size needle to obtain the gauge.**

SHOP KIT

**Finished measurements: 9½" (24 cm)
wide x 42" (107 cm) long**

SPECIAL STITCHES

C10B = Slip the next 5 sts onto a cable
needle and hold to the back of work, knit
the next 5 stitches from the left-hand
needle; then knit the 5 stitches from the
cable needle.

C10F = Slip the next 5 sts onto a cable
needle and hold to the front of work, knit
the next 5 stitches from the left-hand
needle; then knit the 5 stitches from the
cable needle.

Seed Stitch

**(worked over an even number
of sts)**

Row 1 (right side): *K1, P1; repeat from * to
end of row.

Row 2 (wrong side): *P1, K1; repeat from *
to end of row.

Rows 3-4: Repeat Rows 1-2.

Woven Cable Pattern

Row 1 (right side): Knit.

Row 2 (wrong side): Purl.

Row 3: K1, C10F, *K5, C10F; repeat from * to
last 6 sts, K6.

Rows 4-8: Work in Stockinette St (knit on
right side, purl on wrong side), starting with
a purl row.

Row 9: K6, C10B, *K5, C10B; repeat from *
to last st, K1.

Rows 10-12: Work in Stockinette St,
starting with a purl row.
Repeat Rows 1-12 for Woven Cable Pattern.

SCARF

Cast on 40 sts.

Rows 1-4: Work in Seed St.

Row 5: Work first 4 sts in Seed St, work
center 32 sts in first row of Woven Cable
Pattern, work last 4 sts in Seed St.

Continue in pattern until piece measures 41"
(104 cm) from cast on edge.

Repeat Rows 1-4.

Bind off all sts.

FINISHING

With yarn needle, weave in loose ends.
Block lightly.

Place button 16" (41 cm) from bind off edge
and 4" (10 cm) from the side edge of scarf.
Using sewing needle and thread, sew button
to scarf. With bind off edge at back of neck,
wrap scarf around neck once. Due to the
bulky yarn and large stitches, no buttonhole
is made. Instead, push Abalone shell
button between the stitches opposite the cable to
secure around neck.

cm = centimeters; **K** = knit; **mm** =
millimeters; **P** = purl; **st(s)** = stitch(es); * =
repeat whatever follows the * as indicated.



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
