



 KNIT | SKILL LEVEL: EASY

### MEASUREMENTS

Approx 42 x 48" [106.5 x 122 cm].

### GAUGE

8 sts and 13 rows = 4" [10 cm] in stocking st.

### INSTRUCTIONS

#### Stripe Pat

With A, work 24 rows.

With B, work 24 rows.

With C, work 24 rows.

With D, work 24 rows.

With E, work 24 rows.

These 120 rows form Stripe Pat.

Cast on 111 sts. **Do not** join. Working back and forth across needle in rows, proceed as follows:

**1st row:** (RS). K1. ssk. K9. \*Center dec. K9. Rep from \* to last 3 sts. K2tog. K1.

**2nd row:** K1. \*P1. K4. (K1. yo. K1) in next st. K4. Rep from \* to last 2 sts. P1. K1.

Last 2 rows form pat. First 2 rows of Stripe Pat are complete.

Cont in pat as established until 120 rows of Stripe Pat are complete. Cast off.

### MATERIALS

**Bernat® Blanket Brights™** (10.5 oz/300 g; 220 yds/201 m)

**Contrast A** Race Car Red (12001)      **1 ball or 114 yds/104 m**

**Contrast B** Carrot Orange (12002)      **1 ball or 114 yds/104 m**

**Contrast C** School Bus Yellow (12003)      **1 ball or 114 yds/104 m**

**Contrast D** Go Go Green (12004)      **1 ball or 114 yds/104 m**

**Contrast E** Royal Blue (12006)      **1 ball or 114 yds/104 m**

Size U.S. 11 (8 mm) circular knitting needle 40" [101.5 cm] long **or size needed to obtain gauge.**

### ABBREVIATIONS:

**Approx** = Approximate(ly)

**Center Dec** = (worked over 3 sts). Slip next 2 stitches as if to K2tog, K1, then pass slipped sts over knit stitch – center of 3 sts should be on top of decrease, 2 stitches have been decreased

**Cont** = Continue(ing)

**K** = Knit

**K2tog** = Knit next 2 stitches together

**Pat** = Pattern

**P** = Purl

**Rep** = Repeat

**RS** = Right side

**Ssk** = Slip next 2 stitches knitwise one at a time. Pass them back onto left-hand needle, then knit through back loops together

**St(s)** = Stitch(es)

**Yo** = Yarn over
