

RIBBED HAT AND SCARF | KNIT

SHOP KIT



Ribbed Hat and Scarf

Scarf measures 7" x 67". Hat Circumference is 23".

RED HEART® Boutique™ "Swirl™": *Scarf* - 2 balls 9532 Fuchsia; *Hat* - 1 ball 9532 Fuchsia.

Knitting Needles: 8mm [US 11"].

Circular Knitting Needles: 8mm [US 11] 16" long. Double Pointed Needles: 1 set 8mm [US 11].

Yarn needle.

GAUGE: 11 sts = 4"; 18 rows/rounds = 4" in Rib pattern. **CHECK YOUR GAUGE.** Use any size needles to obtain the gauge.

NOTE

Hat is worked in the round. As stitches are decreased and no longer fit on circular needle, divide them among 3 double pointed needles to complete.

SCARF

With knitting needles, cast on 21 sts.

Row 1 (Wrong Side): * P3, k3; repeat from * to last 3 sts, p3. Row 2: * [K1, wrapping yarn around needle twice for each st] 3 times, p3; repeat from * to last 3 sts, [k1, wrapping yarn around needle twice for each st] 3 times.

Row 3: Work across in rib pattern as established, dropping extra wraps from needle.

Repeat Rows 2 and 3 until piece measures 67". Bind off.

FINISHING

Pompom

Make two $2\frac{1}{2}$ " pompoms. Sew a pompom to each end. Weave in yarn ends.

HAT

With circular needles, cast on 64 sts. Place marker for beginning of round and join, being careful not to twist sts. **Round 1:** * P2, k2; repeat from * around. Repeat Round 1 until piece measures 9½".

Shape Crown

Round 1: * P2tog, k2; repeat from * around–48 sts. Rounds 2 – 5: * P1, k2; repeat from * around. Round 6: * P1, k2tog; repeat from * around–32 sts. Rounds 7 – 10: * P1, k1: repeat from * around. Round 11: * K2tog; repeat from * around–16 sts.

Round 12: Repeat Round 11-8 sts.

Cut yarn leaving long tail. Thread tail through remaining sts and pull tightly to secure. Weave in yarn ends.
