What you will need:

RED HEART® Mixology Solids™:

3 balls 263 Coral A

RED HEART® Mixology Prints™:

4 balls 931 Sizzling Print B

Susan Bates® Circular Knitting

Needles: 10mm [US 15] 32" long

Yarn needle

GAUGE: 6 sts = 3.25" [8 cm];
8 rows = 2.75" [7 cm] in stitch
pattern. **CHECK YOUR GAUGE.**
Use any size needle to obtain
the gauge.

Tasseled Triangular Shawl

Unique texture and fashion colors combine for a lacy shawl finished off with a tassel at each corner. It's knit from the lower point up to the shoulders with coordinating shades of Mixology in a print and a solid.

Shawl Finished Measurements:

62" wide x 34" long [157 cm x 86 cm],
not including tassels.

NOTE

Shawl is worked from lower point (cast on edge) to top edge (across back and shoulders).

SPECIAL ABBREVIATIONS

Sl2k1p = slip 2 purlwise, k1, pass both slipped stitches over the knit stitch.

SKP = slip 1 purlwise, k1, pass slipped stitch over the knit stitch.

YO = Yarn over.

SHAWL

With **A**, cast on 3 sts.

Row 1: K3.

Row 2 (Right Side): K1, (k1 in front, k1 in back, k1 in front) of next st, k1—5 sts.

Rows 3: K5.

Row 4: K2, yo, k1, yo, k2—7 sts.

Row 5 (and all odd numbered rows): K2, purl to last 2 sts, k2.

Row 6: K2, yo, k3, yo, k2—9 sts.

Row 8: K2, yo, k1, *yo, sl2k1p, yo, k1, yo, k2—11 sts.

Row 10: K2, yo, skp, yo, k3, yo, skp, yo, k2—13 sts.

Row 12: K2, yo, k3, yo, sl2k1p, yo, k3, yo, k2—15 sts.

Row 14: K2, yo, k1, yo, sl2k1p, yo, k3, yo, sl2k1p, yo, k1, yo, k2—17 sts.

Row 16: K2, yo, skp, yo, k3, yo, sl2k1p, yo, k3, yo, skp, yo, k2—19 sts.

Row 18: K2, yo, *k3, yo, sl2k1p, yo; repeat from * to last 5 sts, k3, yo, k2—21 sts.

Row 20: K2, yo, k1, *yo, sl2k1p, yo, k3; repeat from * to last 6 sts, yo, sl2k1p, yo, k1, yo, k2—23 sts.

Cut **A**, change to **B**.

Row 22: K2, yo, skp, yo, k3, *yo, sl2k1p, yo, k3; repeat from * to last 4 sts, yo, skp, yo, k2—25 sts.

Row 24: K2, yo, k3, *yo, sl2k1p, yo, k3; repeat from * to last 2 sts, yo, k2—27 sts.

Row 26: K2, yo, k1, yo, sl2k1p, yo, *k3, yo, sl2k1p, yo; repeat from * to last 3 sts, k1, yo, k2—29 sts.

Row 28: K2, yo, skp, yo, k3, *yo, sl2k1p, yo, k3; repeat from * to last 4 sts, yo, skp, yo, k2—31 sts.

Cut **B**, change to **A**.

Row 30: K2, yo, k3, *yo, sl2k1p, yo, k3; repeat from * to last 2 sts, yo, k2—33 sts.

Row 32: K2, yo, k1, yo, sl2k1p, yo, *k3, yo, sl2k1p, yo; repeat from * to last 3 sts, k1, yo, k2—35 sts.

Row 34: K2, yo, skp, yo, k3, *yo, sl2k1p, yo, k3; repeat from * to last 4 sts, yo, skp, yo, k2—37 sts.

Row 36: K2, yo, k3, *yo, sl2k1p, yo, k3; repeat from * to last 2 sts, yo, k2—39 sts.

Row 38: K2, yo, k1, yo, sl2k1p, yo, *k3, yo, sl2k1p, yo; repeat from * to last 3 sts, k1, yo, k2—41 sts.

Row 40: K2, yo, skp, yo, k3, *yo, sl2k1p, yo, k3; repeat from * to last 4 sts, yo, skp, yo, k2—43 sts.

Row 42: K2, yo, k3, *yo, sl2k1p, yo, k3; repeat from * to last 2 sts, yo, k2—45 sts.

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SHOP KIT

Row 44: K2, yo, k1, yo, sl2k1p, yo, *k3, yo, sl2k1p, yo; repeat from * to last 3 sts, k1, yo, k2—47 sts.

Cut **A**, change to **B**.

Repeat Rows 34-45 for pattern and change colors as in the following color sequence: work [next 8 rows with **B**, and next 16 rows with **A**] twice—95 sts. Cut **A**, change to **B**.

Rows 92-95: K2, yo, k to last 2 sts, yo, k2—103 sts.

Next Row: Bind off all stitches.

TASSELS (make 3)

With **B**, cut 12 strands of yarn measuring 24" [61 cm] long. Hold all 12 strands together and fold in half forming a loop at folded end. Draw loop through bottom corner of shawl, thread ends of strands through loop and pull tightly to secure. Cut tassel ends to 7.5–8" [19-20 cm] in length and trim ends. Repeat attaching 1 tassel to each corner of bind off edge.

FINISHING

Using yarn needle, weave in ends.

ABBREVIATIONS

A = Color A; **B** = Color B; **cm** = centimeter; **K** = Knit; **mm** = millimeters; **P** = Purl; **st(s)** = Stitch(es); **St st** = Stockinette stitch; **[]** = work directions in brackets the number of times specified; *** or **** = repeat whatever follows the * or ** as indicated.
